Scenario (SharePoint + Power Automate)

A SharePoint list called Requests has:

- Title (text)
- RequestedBy (Person)
- Status (Choice: New / In Review / Approved / Rejected)

When a request is **Approved**, the person in RequestedBy should get an email that includes a **link to the SharePoint item**.

The flow must **not** run for every other edit (title changes, comments, Status = In Review, etc.).

Your Challenge

A Requests list should email the person in RequestedBy (with a **link to the item**) when Status becomes **Approved** — and the flow should **not** run on every other edit.

Answer the questions below:

1. What trigger should be used?
2. How you stop it from running on every edit
3. Which action is used for email + what you use for the item link to make it clickable in the email
